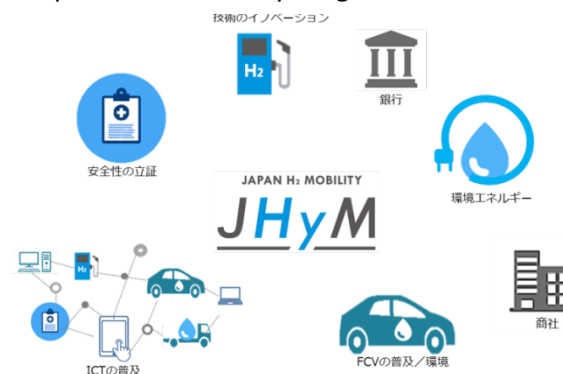
Japan H₂ Mobility, LLC (JHyM) Adds Five More Investor Companies to Roster
