

4 new HRS installed in fiscal 2021

The joint applications of JHyM (Japan H2 Mobility, LLC) and its members for the government subsidy program promoting the installation of hydrogen refueling stations (HRS) for commercial use have been adopted. Herewith, 4 new HRS are to be installed and 1 new company, Satonenryo, has joined in JHyM; the number of JHyM's HRS becomes 63 units and the one of JHyM's participating companies has become 26. The HRS adopted in the past being added, there will be 152 units/166 locations nationwide.

JHyM will continue to facilitate HRS development this fiscal year.
